
More difficult when organic gardening sometimes manual removal is actually most effective Some are still toxic at high concentrations

Non GMO

Have not been genetically modified in any way



Heirloom

denoting a traditional variety of plant which is not associated with large-scale commercial agriculture. And passes on predictable traits to its offspring. Versus Hybrids which can be a cross of Heirloom and other varieties.



Organic

Seeds can be GMO and Grown Organically. Seeds Can be Heirloom and grown conventionally. Just because is says Heirloom and Non-GMO doesn't mean it's also organic.



When to sow outside: Recommended for mild winter climates only: 1 to 2 weeks before average last frost and when soil temperatures are at least 60° F.

When to start inside: RECOMMENDED. 6 to 8 weeks before average last frost.




